

Candle Creek Falls

Location: Wells Gray Provincial Park, British Columbia

Drive Time from Spahats Creek Resort: 6 minutes (7.6 km / 4.7 miles)

Parking for RV's: Excellent parking for Rvs and larger vehicles.

Walking Distance from Spahats Creek Resort: Not recommended due to the distance and lack of pedestrian pathways.

Difficulty: Moderate

Distance of Hike: 4 km (2.5 miles) round trip

Elevation Change: Approximately 100 meters (330 feet)

Estimated Hike Time: 1.5 to 2 hours

Overview: Candle Creek Falls is a serene and picturesque waterfall nestled deep within the forests of Wells Gray Provincial Park. The trail to this hidden gem offers visitors a peaceful journey through lush greenery, culminating in the stunning sight of water cascading over basalt rock formations. This hike is ideal for nature enthusiasts looking for a tranquil and rewarding outdoor adventure.

Drive Description: From Spahats Creek Resort, drive back to the main entrance and turn left (west) onto Spahats Creek Road for 600 meters (0.3 miles). Turn left (south) onto Clearwater Valley Road and continue for 7 km (4.3 miles). Look for the clearly marked parking area for Candle Creek Falls on your right.

Hike Description:

1. Begin at the trailhead and follow the well-maintained path through a mix of open areas and dense forest.
2. The trail is relatively steep with a few very steep inclines, making it at times a challenging hike.
3. After approximately 2 km (1.25 miles), you will reach Candle Creek Falls. The cascading water framed by lush foliage creates a perfect setting for relaxation or photography.
4. For those looking to explore further, the trail connects to the Clearwater River Trail for an extended hiking experience. Please note, continuing along the Clearwater River Trail

requires either two vehicles for a point-to-point hike or a return hike back to the Candle Creek Falls parking lot.

5. Return via the same trail for a total distance of 4 km (2.5 miles).

Tips:

- Wear sturdy hiking shoes, as some sections of the trail may be uneven or muddy.
- Pack water and snacks; there are no facilities along the trail.
- Morning or evening hikes are recommended to avoid crowds and enjoy cooler temperatures.
- Bring a camera to capture the beauty of the falls and surrounding nature.
