

Clearwater River Trail

Location: Wells Gray Provincial Park to the town of Clearwater, British Columbia

Starting Point: Triple Decker Falls Parking Lot

Parking for RV's: Excellent parking for Rvs and larger vehicles.

Ending Point: Town of Clearwater

Difficulty: Moderate to Challenging

Distance of Hike: 10 km (6.2 miles) one way (This distance and direction are for a one-way hike).

Elevation Change: Approximately 200 meters (656 feet)

Estimated Hike Time: 3 to 4 hours one way

Overview: The Clearwater River Trail offers a stunning journey along the Clearwater River, showcasing dramatic river views, dense forests, and serene natural beauty. Starting at the Triple Decker Falls parking lot, the trail winds its way downstream, eventually leading to the town of Clearwater. Trail Description:

1. Begin at the Triple Decker Falls parking lot and follow the well-marked trail towards the Clearwater River.

 3. Pass Candle Creek Falls, a picturesque spot to rest and enjoy the scenery, which is located before reaching the scree field.
 4. The trail includes some moderate inclines, uneven terrain, and very steep sections, requiring sturdy footwear and good fitness levels.
 5. Arrive in the town of Clearwater, where you can find restaurants, shops, and transportation options if needed.
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Tips:

- **Transportation:** This hike requires arranging a second vehicle or transportation from the town of Clearwater back to the Triple Decker Falls parking lot if you plan to hike one way.
- **Gear:** Wear sturdy hiking boots and pack plenty of water, snacks, and layers for changing weather conditions.
- **Wildlife:** Be prepared to encounter wildlife such as deer or birds. Carry bear spray as a precaution.
- **Trail Etiquette:** Stay on marked trails to protect the environment and ensure your safety.
