

Dawson Falls North via Pyramid Campground

Location: Wells Gray Provincial Park, British Columbia

Drive Time from Spahats Creek Resort: 30 minutes (30.5 km / 19 miles)

Walking Distance from Spahats Creek Resort: Not recommended due to the distance.

Difficulty: Moderate

Distance of Hike: 4 km (2.5 miles) round trip

Elevation Change: Approximately 50 meters (164 feet)

Estimated Hike Time: 1 to 1.5 hours round trip

Overview: The Dawson Falls North Trail via Pyramid Campground provides a quieter and less-traveled route to view the spectacular Dawson Falls. This scenic trail meanders through lush forest, following the Murtle River to a stunning vantage point of the falls from the northern side. It's an excellent alternative for those looking to avoid crowds while enjoying the beauty of Wells Gray Provincial Park.

Drive Description: From Spahats Creek Resort, drive back to the main entrance and turn left (west) onto Spahats Creek Road for 600 meters (0.37 miles). Turn right (north) onto Clearwater Valley Road and continue for 30.7 km (19.1 miles). Turn right at Pyramid Campground and drive 1.3 km (0.8 miles) to the parking area on the left.

Hike Description: Begin at the parking lot and walk back down the road for 200 meters (656 feet). On the left, you will see a sign for the Dawson Falls Trailhead Loop. Follow the trail to the fence and go down to the right to walk along the Murtle River, offering views of the falls. Be cautious of eroding riverbanks, particularly near viewing areas. To return, either go back the way you came or follow the river trail along and loop back to the parking area.

Tips:

- **Bug Spray:** Be prepared with bug spray due to the intense number of insects, especially near Pyramid Campground.
- **Footwear:** Wear sturdy walking shoes to navigate potential muddy sections of the trail.
- **Facilities:** Pit toilets are available at Pyramid Campground.
- **Wildlife:** Be cautious and carry bear spray; wildlife sightings are common in this area.

- **Photography:** Bring a camera to capture the quieter, serene view of Dawson Falls from this less-frequented angle.

Summary: The Dawson Falls North Trail via Pyramid Campground offers a serene and unique hiking experience to one of Wells Gray Provincial Park's iconic waterfalls.
