Moul Falls

Location: Wells Gray Provincial Park, British Columbia

Drive Time from Spahats Creek Resort: 8 minutes (10 km / 6.2 miles)

Parking for RV's: Excellent parking for Rvs and larger vehicles.

Walking Distance from Spahats Creek Resort: Not recommended due to the distance and lack of pedestrian pathways.

Difficulty: Moderate

Distance of Hike: 5.5 km (3.4 miles) round trip

Elevation Change: Approximately 120 meters (394 feet)

Estimated Hike Time: 1.5 to 2 hours round trip

Overview: Moul Falls is one of the most popular waterfalls in Wells Gray Provincial Park, offering a unique opportunity to walk behind the cascading water. This moderate hike takes you through a lush forest trail to the impressive falls, making it a must-visit for nature enthusiasts and photographers alike.

Drive Description: From Spahats Creek Resort, drive back to the main entrance and turn left (west) onto Spahats Creek Road for 500 meters (0.3 miles). Hike Description:

- 3. After approximately 2.75 km (1.7 miles), you will arrive at Moul Falls. The powerful cascade and surrounding spray create a cool and refreshing environment.
- 4. For the adventurous, take the short path down to the base of the falls and experience the unique thrill of walking behind the curtain of water.
- 5. Return via the same trail for a total distance of 5.5 km (3.4 miles).

Tips:

- **Footwear:** Wear sturdy shoes with good grip, especially if planning to walk behind the falls, as the area can be slippery.
- **Gear:** Bring a rain jacket or waterproof gear to stay dry near the falls.
- Snacks & Water: Pack enough water and snacks, as there are no facilities along the trail.
- **Photography:** Early mornings or evenings provide the best lighting for capturing the beauty of the falls.
