Silver Tip Falls

Location: Wells Gray Provincial Park, British Columbia

Drive Time from Spahats Creek Resort: 20 minutes (6.3 km / 3.9 miles)

Parking for RV's: Not suitable for anything larger then 18 feet in length.

Walking Distance from Spahats Creek Resort: Not recommended due to the steep and

gravel road.

Difficulty: Moderate

Distance of Hike: 2.5 km (1.6 miles) round trip

Elevation Change: Approximately 100 meters (328 feet)

Estimated Hike Time: 1 to 1.5 hours round trip

Overview: Silver Tip Falls is a hidden gem in Wells Gray Provincial Park, featuring a dramatic cascade that plunges over steep cliffs into the lush forest below. The hike offers a serene escape into nature and a rewarding view of one of the lesser-known waterfalls in the park. The journey also provides access to the road leading to Trophy Flower Meadows, making it a perfect stop for explorers in the area.

Drive Description: From Spahats Creek Resort, drive back to the main entrance and Turn right onto Spahats Creek FSR and continue for 4 km (2.5 miles) to a Y junction. Take the right fork and proceed for another 2.3 km (1.4 miles). This steeper gravel road requires the use of downshifting and good brakes for safe driving. The road becomes narrower and bumpier toward the end, making it unsuitable for larger RVs over 18 feet. Turn left at the sign for Silver Tip Rec Site and follow the road for 200 meters (656 feet), staying to the right until you reach a campsite at the end. There is a small turnaround spot, but it is not suitable for larger vehicles. The trail begins beyond the last campsite, with minimal signage. Follow the creek to enjoy scenic views until you reach the base of the falls.

Hike Description:

- 1. Begin at the trailhead and follow the forested path leading to Silver Tip Falls, from the last rec site follow the trail along the creek.
- 2. The trail includes moderate inclines and some uneven terrain, requiring sturdy footwear.

- 3. After approximately 1.25 km (0.8 miles), you will arrive at a stunning viewpoint of Silver Tip Falls. The waterfall's dramatic drop and surrounding greenery make for a perfect photo opportunity.
- 4. Return via the same trail for a total distance of 2.5 km (1.6 miles).

Tips:

- **Driving Precautions:** Use downshifting to control your descent on the gravel road, and ensure your brakes are in good condition.
- Gear: Wear sturdy hiking boots and bring plenty of water and snacks.
- **Wildlife:** Be prepared to encounter wildlife and carry bear spray as a precaution.
- **Accessibility:** The rough road and narrow sections make this destination better suited for smaller vehicles.

Summary: Silver Tip Falls is a tranquil and rewarding hike that highlights the rugged beauty of Wells Gray Provincial Park.
