

Trophy Flower Meadows Trail to Shepherd's Hut

Location: Wells Gray Provincial Park, British Columbia

Drive Time from Spahats Creek Resort: 30 to 45 minutes (12.2 km / 7.6 miles)

Parking for RV's: Excellent parking for Rvs, however the road is steep at times larger vehicles not recommended.

Walking Distance from Spahats Creek Resort: Not recommended due to the distance and rough terrain.

Difficulty: Moderate

Distance of Hike: 10 km (6.2 miles) round trip to Shepherd's Hut

Elevation Change: Approximately 500 meters (1,640 feet)

Estimated Hike Time: 3 to 5 hours round trip

Overview: The Trophy Flower Meadows Trail is a breathtaking hike through one of Wells Gray Provincial Park's most stunning alpine landscapes. Newly renovated in 2023, the trail offers improved pathways leading to vibrant meadows filled with wildflowers during the bloom season. Shepherd's Hut, located at the trail's end, provides a historic and scenic destination surrounded by panoramic views of the Trophy Mountains.

Drive Description: From Spahats Creek Resort, drive back to the main entrance and turn right onto Spahats Creek FSR. Drive to the 4 km fork and go left, following the signs for Trophy Flower Meadows. The drive involves several steep and winding sections, requiring careful navigation, particularly in larger vehicles. Upon arrival, you will find a newly installed pit toilet at the trailhead and a small parking area suitable for standard-sized vehicles. Larger RVs are not recommended due to the steep climb and descent on the access road.

Hike Description:

1. Begin at the trailhead and follow the newly renovated path through dense forests.
2. The trail gradually ascends, offering occasional glimpses of the surrounding peaks.
3. As you approach the alpine meadows, the landscape opens up to reveal vibrant wildflowers and sweeping mountain views.

4. Continue along the trail to reach Shepherd's Hut, a rustic shelter that provides a perfect spot for a rest and a picnic.
5. Return via the same trail for a total distance of 10 km (6.2 miles).

Tips:

- **Gear:** Wear sturdy hiking boots and bring plenty of water, snacks, and layers for changing weather conditions.
- **Seasonal Note:** The wildflower bloom is typically at its peak from late-June to early August.
- **Facilities:** A new pit toilet is available at the trailhead for convenience.
- **Wildlife:** Carry bear spray and be aware of wildlife, including deer, marmots, and bears.
